

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE JUBILEE COMMITTEE HELD ON WEDS 23
MARCH at 7.30 p.m.

1. Present. David Silver, Ian Thomas, Huw Onllwyn Jones, Allan Cook.
2. Apologies. Vina Patel, Ann Rosser, Moy Lewis.
3. Minutes of the previous meeting agreed to be correct.
4. David Silver reported that the booking of the Comp was confirmed. He, Vina and Allan had met with Gale the Site Manager at the Comp. They had had a very successful meeting and Gale is more than willing to give her support to the event. Sites for the entertainment, BBQ's and bar and the Beacon were discussed.

8. We are awaiting Mike Clarke to give us the cost of fireworks. Keith Porter, who set up the beacon in the past will look after the beacon once again. Allan reported that he, Julie and Karl had looked at the Beacon in the store of the OCR and it was in good condition. Keith said that stood on its own feet. Allan felt, that in these days of heightened Health and Safety, it might need some extra metal pins in the foot to give added safety.
9. The water bottles design had been confirmed with the logo in Welsh and English. Allan said the company were extremely efficient. (Since then the bottles have been ordered and should arrive at the end of this week. We had a further discount so the bottles will cost a little under £1,100.)
10. The Committee agreed to a Competition to design a crown, to be worn/displayed at the Picnic. Vina to speak to the heads of the two Primary Schools.
11. Allan reported that he had been told of several street parties being planned.

12. It was agreed to buy 4x 240 metre lengths of bunting at a cost of £15 per length. (Bunting has arrived)
